Project Overview:

Providing people in need a way to cook their food with the power of the sun. Making these ovens available in a way that

allows the recipients to accept the ovens with dignity and self respect while also providing a way for people to get to know

how our actions impact each other.

Currently there are families receiving food through the USDA criteria. These people are having difficulty paying their utility bills. Yet food has to be cooked to feed their families.

We can predict that the cost of cooking food will continue to be added to the utility bills of the families if no action is taken to change it.

How might recipient families be impacted:

• We allow recipient families, living close to the edge financially, to do 12 hours of community service which we

have them keep track of. We show the family how to use the solar cookers and deliver them.

- Might the recipient families feel empowered?
- Might they be learning about living a more earth-centered life?
- Might they see how delicious food can taste cooked by the power of the sun?

Recipients will be encouraged to give feedback at the end of the first month and again at the end of the second month.

- We allow people to help within their financial ability.

making these ovens available at special prices?
